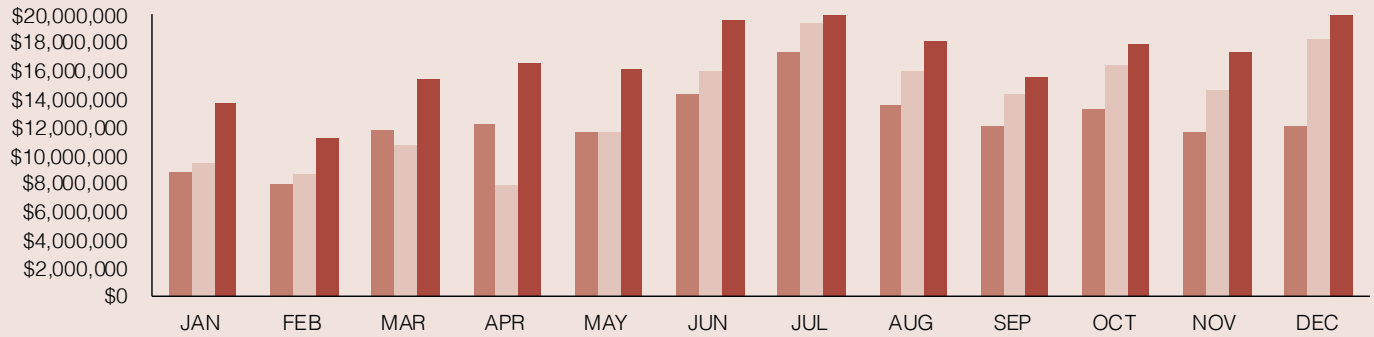




# Gas & Grocery Revenue

In 2021, rising crude oil prices and increased gasoline demand contributed to an average, national price per gallon of \$3.01, the highest average nominal price since 2014. While affordable gasoline is important to a drive-tourism market like Pigeon Forge, as it allows visitors to allocate additional money to other activities, this increase highlights that even with relatively high gas prices visitors are willing to continue to visit and enjoy a range of activities.
